#### MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION

**COPAPHIL** was founded in July 1983, the 200th anniversary of the birth of Simon Bolivar, the liberator of Colombia and its first president. It has been APS Affiliate #142 since August 1985. The purpose of the organization is to promote the philately of Colombia and Panama.

**COPAPHIL** developed a reference library that contained the largest existing collection of literature relating to the philately of Colombia and Panama. To ensure access, the library was donated to the American Philatelic Research Library (stamps.org/Services/Library). Inquiries should be directed to the APRL librarian.

#### **Benefits of Membership:**

The quarterly journal, COPACARTA, includes original research as well as translations of articles published in foreign language journals and reprints of articles of interest from older publications. Ten year indexes are distributed free to members; the most recent was of Volumes 21-30. COPACARTA is sent to all overseas members by airmail.
