COPAPHIL was founded in July 1983, the 200th anniversary of the birth of Simon Bolivar, the liberator of Colombia and its first president. It has been APS Affiliate #142 since August 1985. The purpose of the organization is to promote the philately of Colombia and Panama.

COPAPHIL has developed and continues to add to its library, reference collection and Colombia postmark collection. The library contains the largest existing collection of literature relating to the philately of Colombia and Panama. To ensure access, the library was donated to the American Philatelic Research Library www.stamplib.org in 2008; inquiries should be directed to the APRL librarian. The reference collection was donated to the American Philatelic Society www.stamps.org; Inquiries should be directed to the APS. ✉ **Specialized handbooks free or at reduced cost to members.** Our first was the landmark *Philatelic Bibliography for Colombia and Panama*. It was distributed free to all members in 2001. The second publication was a *Handbook of Panama Postal Markings through 1950*. It was offered to members at a greatly reduced cost. A new edition is in preparation.

Currently available is *The Stamps of Panama 1878-2007: Vital Statistics* by Federico Brid. This handbook includes essential information including postal rates, authorization decrees and numbers printed. One copy is available to members for \$11.95 plus postage. Additional copies are \$21.95 plus postage: US \$3.50 media mail, \$4.95 priority mail; Canada 1st class \$6.55; elsewhere \$13.00. Payment must be made in US dollars drawn on a US bank.
