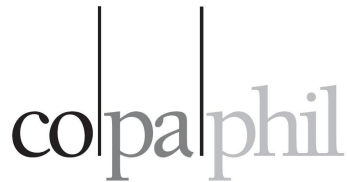

COPAPHIL was founded in July 1983, the 200th anniversary of the birth of Simon Bolivar, the liberator of Colombia and its first president. It has been APS Affiliate #142 since August 1985. The purpose of the organization is to promote the philately of Colombia and Panama.

COPAPHIL developed a reference library that contained the largest existing collection of literature relating to the philately of Colombia and Panama. To ensure access, the library was donated to the American Philatelic Research Library (www.stamplib.org). Inquiries should be directed to the APRL librarian.

Benefits of Membership:

The quarterly journal, COPACARTA, includes original research as well as translations of articles published in foreign language journals and reprints of articles of interest from older publications. It is sent to all overseas members by airmail.

Specialized handbooks free or at reduced cost to members. The current publications available are:

Handbook of Panama Postal Markings through 1950. (2nd edition) by Jim Cross. Copies, postpaid, are \$35 in the United States and \$50 elsewhere. Members entitled to a \$10 discount.

The Stamps of Panama 1878-2007: Vital Statistics by Federico Brid. This handbook includes essential information including postal rates, authorization decrees and numbers printed. One copy is available to members for \$20 in the United States and \$30 elsewhere. Additional copies are \$30 in the United States and \$40 elsewhere. Members entitled to a \$10 discount on additional copies.

The Michelsen affair and the "reprints" of \$5 and \$10 of the 1868 issue of the United States of Colombia by Dario Diaz. The cost is \$15 plus \$3 postage in the United States and \$10 postage elsewhere. Members entitled to a \$5 discount.
